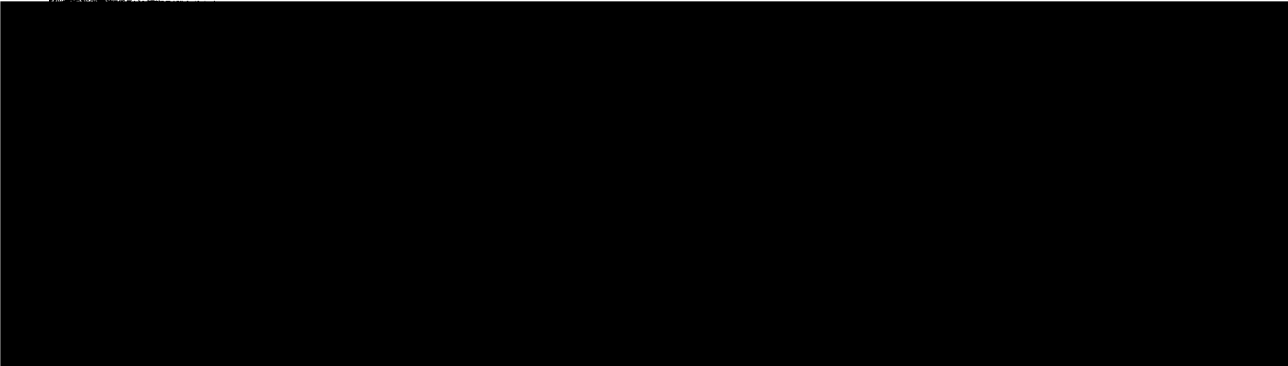

1. LIU Po-ch'eng, chairman of the Southwest Military and Administrative Committee, left Chungking on 15 January and went to Peiping to become deputy general chief of staff of the Far East Army<sup>1</sup> Headquarters.
2. At present HO Lung<sup>2</sup> (賀龍) is in charge of military affairs in Southwest China and TENG Hsiao-p'ing<sup>2</sup> (鄧小平) is in charge of political and party affairs.
