1. On 30 May 1951, the Pioneer Kaserne on Garter Strasse, Fuerstenwalde (N 53/T 33), quartered only a rear detail which was still engaged in the training of tank and truck drivers. Truck 7-44-77 was identified at the installation.
2. The Keiter Kaserne was occupied by only a rear detail. No training activity was noticed. There appeared to be a repair shop in a detached building opposite the barracks gate. Truck B 3-62-76 was parked there.
3. The partly destroyed Marslstour Kaserne was occupied by only a guard detail.
4. The former high school on the road to Hangelsberg quartered 100 to 120 soldiers who wore red-bordered black epaulets. No vehicular traffic was noticed.
