25X1C 1. Between 7 and 26 May 1951, the Soviet troops quartered on the premises of the Norddeutsche Werke in Luckenwalde (N 53/Z 70) regularly engaged in morning callisthenics, but did no training. Three groups of 30 to 35 men each marched out to take a bath once a week. Motor vehicles [Redacted] were identified. 25X1C

25X1C 2. Motor vehicles parked in front of the komendantura on Willi-Scholz-Strasse included sedans [Redacted] and vehicles [Redacted]

25X1C 3. Security measures at the anti-tank switch position on Kottower Strasse were intensified.

25X1C 4. Only little activity was observed at the Soviet quarters in the former German Stalags (PW base camps) I through III. On 25 May, a soccer team wearing red-bordered black epaulets left the installation for the athletic field on truck [Redacted]

25X1C 5. Trucks picking up supplies at the piano factory on Neue Baruther Strasse between 22 and 26 May were numbered [Redacted] * 25X1C

* 25X1A Comment. 25X1C [Redacted] indicates no change in the situation at the Luckenwalde post. Most of the motor vehicle numbers reported belong to the Third Gds Mezz Army. [Redacted] 25X1A
