HONG In-pyo, born 1 March 1921; member of the South Korean Labor Party; 70 Kongtok-dong, Mapo-ku; remained in Seoul when the United Nations forces returned there.

HWANG Yong-chun, born 12 June 1931: 70 Kongtok-dong, Kapo-ku; member of the administrative section of the FAA; retreated from Secul in September 1950 and returned on 5 January 1951.

KIM Chin-hang, born 5 October 1924; member of the Worth Korean Labor Party; Kacdong, Chongne-ku; Art Studio dormitory; head of the organization section of the FAA; remained in Seoul during the first United Nations tenure.

KIM Hwa-chun, born 11 August 1931; Madong, Chongac-ku, Art Studio dormitory; remained in Seoul during the first United Nations temme.

PAEK In-kyun, born 13 October 1923; number of the North Kerean Labor Pervy; 402-7, Sintang-dong, Songtong-ku; head of the cartoon section of the FAA; remained in Seoul during the first United Nations temme.

PAEK Sung-yol, born 11 September 1913; Knedong, Chongno-ku, Art Studio dermitory; remained in Seoul during the first United Mations tenure.

PANG In-wor, born 4 June 1906; member of the South Korean Labor Party; Knedeng, Chongno-ku, Art Studio dermitory; formerly principal of Taejon Normal School; retreated from Seoul in September 1950 and returned in Junuary 1951.

SO Chong-hwan, born 14 May 1931, 154, 3-km, Myonggun-dong, Chongno-ku, remained in Seoul during the first United Notions tenure.
