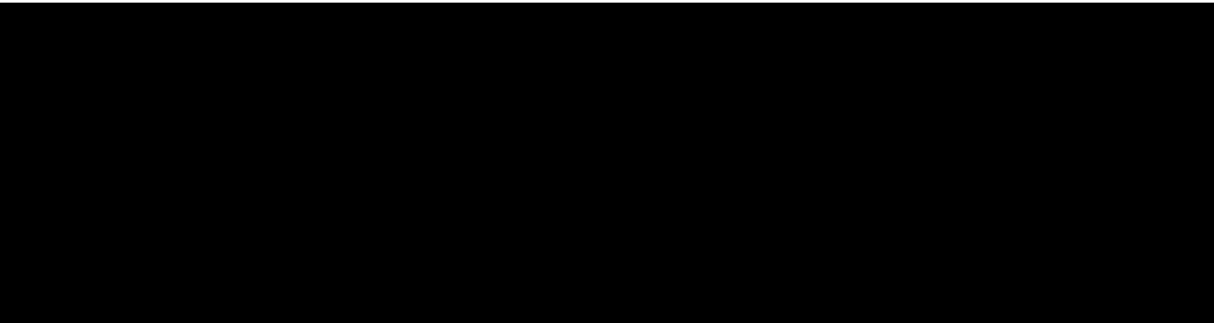

A statement issued to the chairman of the Partisan Military Committee of Cholla Province from a higher headquarters in the north contained the following instructions:

Under the present war situation at home, caused by the temporary occupation by force of the southern part of Korea by United States imperialists, Syngman Rhee, and our enemies, the Central Party Military Committee instructs the Partisan Military Committee to devote itself to the motherland and the people through armed warfare, as follows:

In conjunction with armed warfare, public agitation is to be maintained, and a pacification organization is to be established on a large scale in the intervals of partisan warfare conducted by the provincial branch of the party.

- a. All members of the provincial branch of the party are to be organized in partises and a secret district party branch members organized for reconnaissance of the enemy.
- b. Men of other organizations, if enthusiastic and willing to cooperate with our party, will be enrolled and put in place of party members who are participating in partisan warfare in order to carry on political affairs in the rear area.
- c. Ideological and political training should be continually given to new party members and to partisans with party membership so that they will be devoted and swifter in their role of nucleus for activities, with high confidence in victory and a will to fight.
- d. In order to elevate the people's confidence of victory and to disclose and break down the demoralizing policies of the enemy, public agitation should be organized in conjunction with partisan units.

A means of joint operations should be worked out and communications should be set up with People's Army units operating in North Cholla.

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY

- a. By unifying the people in the rear ideologically, versatile operations may be gained by People's Army units.
- b. To assist People's Army units active near Hoeman-san (127-08, 35-31) in Suncheng County, all enemy expeditionary units in the area should be attacked until none is left.
- c. By completing measures to raise political confidence and acquire military supplies, and by the acquisition of supplies, the operation of armed units will be aided.

Fighting and the combat area for destruction of enemy supply lines in the rear should be extended, so that the enemy will have no respite and no time to dispose his forces.

- a. Operations for sudden attacks on enemy supply lines by partisan units should be strengthened and emboldened.
- b. Extensive party activities should be carried on with underground personnel so as to secure a strategic fortified base for action of partisan units.

Reconnaissance organization should be extended outside the cities.
