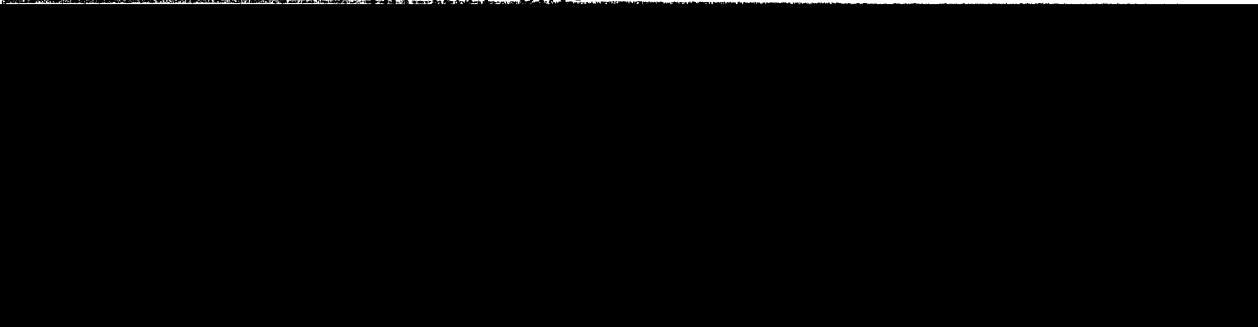

1. Ljubljana is the headquarters of the Army to which the 61 Infantry Division is attached. The headquarters of the 61 Infantry Division is in Ilirska Bistrica, and the headquarters of the 10 Infantry Regiment is in Klana, near Rijeka. All battalion headquarters of the 10 Regiment are in Klana.

3. The infantry units of the Regiment are supplied with standard Yugoslav armament. Each company has four automatic rifles, six automatic pistols, and former German rifles for the enlisted men. The Machine Gun Company is equipped with two heavy Maxime guns, and two additional light machine guns. Soldiers on duty are supplied with 15 bullets per rifle. The Artillery Battalion of the Regiment has five 45 mm. cannons, five 120 mm. mortars, and twelve 82 mm. mortars.
