1. Soviet diplomatic and consular missions have been ordered to protect the itineraries of Soviet diplomatic travelers in order to hinder foreign efforts at surveillance. This is to be accomplished by the following measures:
 - a. Making travel reservations and purchasing tickets only from the point of departure to the first stop on any trip. The Soviet embassy, legation, or consulate at that point will make the necessary reservations and purchase tickets for the next stage of the journey, etc.
 - b. The Soviet diplomatic mission which purchases the tickets is to pay the expenses incurred by the traveler during that stage of his journey. Each mission is to set up an accounting system for this purpose.
2. The order is reported to stress the importance of using the new method particularly in arranging journeys from the traveler's permanent post to other countries.
