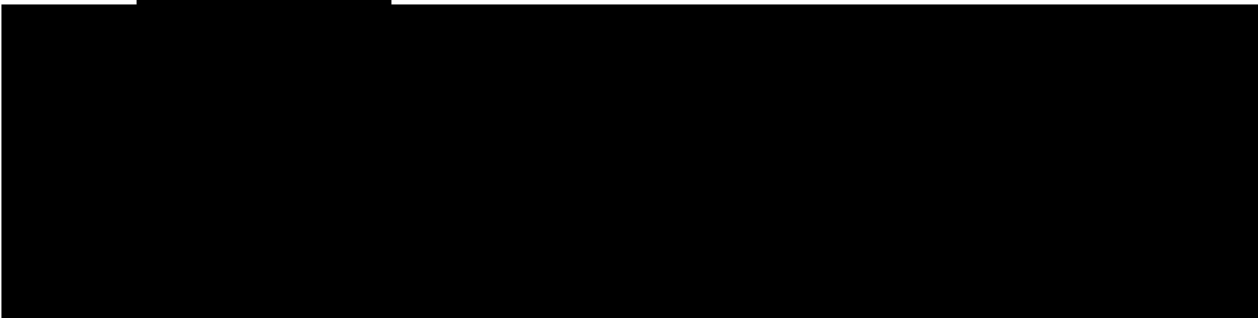

- Three bomber regiments.

3. The following units were observed on 14 July:

- Two fighter regiments each at Alt Lönnewitz and Finow.
- One fighter regiment each at Köthen, Brandenburg-Briest, Grossenhain, Brandis, Lärz, Neuruppin, Peenemünde, and Wittstock.
- Three ground-attack units (regiments?).
- Two bomber regiments.
