SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO. 25X1X



1. It is stated that there has recently been a visible increase in the number of Soviet troops and vehicles in Budapest.
2. Soviet troops are allegedly located at Balaton-Földvár. A Soviet general, with two Soviet colonels and two other field-grade officers, was seen at Balatonalmádi during the last week of June 1951.
3. A barracks and a hotel at Pecs have been evacuated, allegedly to make room for Soviet officers and troops who are expected to arrive there.
4. The rumor is circulating in Budapest that the supreme command of armed forces in Hungary has been given to a Russian general named Svetaev (or Tsvetayev).
5. The villa in Budapest formerly occupied by Arpad Szakasits was heavily guarded on 5 and 6 June.
6. A large new explosives plant has been completed in Peta (sic; perhaps Pata or Pet).
