1. The airfield was several kilometers west of Kherson (32°36' E/46°39' N), Ukrainian SSR.
2. Parachuting from individual Douglas planes was observed. Twelve parachutists each equipped with two parachutes, jumped from each plane.

Comment:

The airfield west-northwest of Kherson, south of the road to Nikolayev, known since the German occupation, had no runway. From the few reported facts it is assumed that the field is occupied by a small parachute unit. This assumption requires confirmation by more recent reports.
