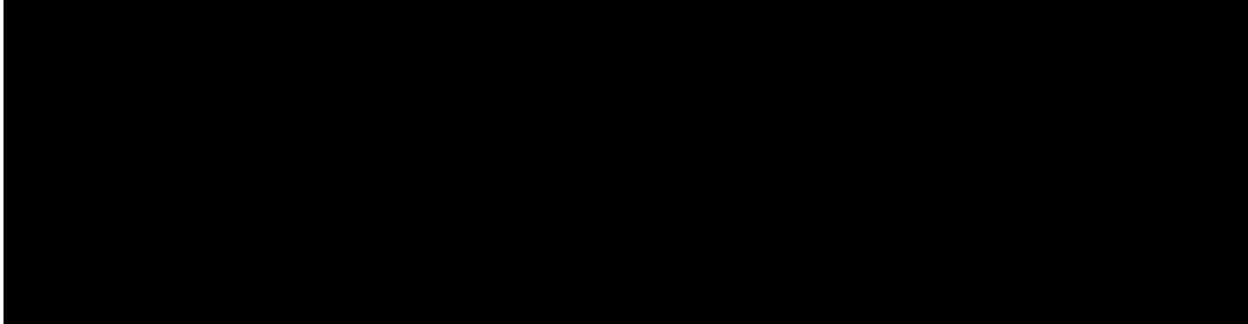

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NOS



1. One of the largest ammunition dumps in Hungary, located at Devceser (P48/Y38), is at the disposal of the Soviet Army. There are a total of 39 dumps in the Devceser area and they are guarded by some 150 Soviet soldiers. Two watch towers, each 25 meters high, and equipped with HMGs and powerful searchlights, are located within the dump area. Although the dumps were not bombed during World War II, the surrounding area was mined to prevent access by the partisans.
2. The dumps are said to be constructed with three semi-floors (sic) above the ground and four underground floors. The total capacity of the dumps is not known. Ammunition and arms are transported to the dumps over two railroad spur lines as well as by truck.
