




- The airfield about 800 meters southeast of the Chernyakhovsk (21048'E/54036'N), Kaliningrad Oblast, railroad transloading station, was about 1000 x 1,500 meters, and had a concrete runway 40 to 50 x 1,000 meters.
- 2. A hangar, about 50 x 100 meters, and a 25 x 30-meter stone building were on the northern edge of the field and an emergency hangar, about 30 x 80 meters, was in the southern part of the field.
- 3. A fuel installation about 600 meters north of the field had 8 to 10 semiunderground containers.
- 4. Ground lights and six searchlights were arranged around the field.
- The field was occupied by about 20 fighters, 10 IL-2s, and 25 biplanes.

Comment:

This out-dated report is transmitted only for the date indicating the serviceability of the field. It is known that hangars and billets were on the southern edge of the field and that the E-W runway was 1,200 meters long. More recent reports are required to clarify the occupation.
