- 1. Between 5 and 8 July 1951, four trains carrying troops and engineer and billeting equipment were dispatched from Potsdam to Bernburg.
- 2. On 5 July, two trains carrying troops of the Second Guards AAA Division stationed in Potsdam were dispatched to Kroepelin.*
- 3. The following observations were made on 10 July:
 - a. One train carrying troops of the First Mechanized Division and materiel, including heavy mortars and rocket launchers, stood at Neuruppin rail station.
 - b. Troops of the 12th Guards Tank Division accompanied by 16 field howitzers, 16 x 120 mm. mortars, four AT guns, and four rocket launchers were loaded in Neuropein on two trains which departed toward Neustadt/Dosse.
 - c. One troop train carrying 250 men and 35 pieces of heavy artillery arrived in Oranienburg.
- 4. On 11 and 12 July, troops, 20 rocket launchers, 12 pieces of artillery, and about 40 trucks of the rocket launcher regiment and the artillery brigade of the Second Guards Michanized Army were loaded in Oranienburg on two trains which were dispatched toward Kremmen.
