- The following troop trains were seen leaving the Neuruppin (N 53/2 49) railroad station toward Neustadt on the Dosse River on 10 July 1951:
 4:10 p.m. Train of 17 flatcars and 9 boxcars carrying about 450 troops who wore red-bordered black epaulets with artillery insignia and were equipped with 16 x 120 - mm mortars, 2 trucks with numbers of the [redacted], 2 trucks with numbers of the [redacted], 17 trucks with numbers of the [redacted] and 2 trucks with numbers of the [redacted].
 4:45 p.m. Train of 22 flatcars and 6 boxcars carrying about 400 troops who wore red-bordered black epaulets with artillery insignia and were equipped with 16 x 122-mm field howitzers, 4 artillery pieces of about 100 mm, 4 model M-13 rocket launchers, and 31 trucks, 4 of which had numbers of the [redacted], 19 numbers of the E 1-07-xx series, 4 numbers of the [redacted], 1 a number of the [redacted] series and 3 numbers of the [redacted].
 - Fifteen railroad cars carrying 6 heavy mortars, 2 rocket launchers, and trucks [redacted] were observed at the Neuruppin railroad station at 9 p.m. on 10 July. **
- 25X1A Comment. The two trains carried components of the 12th Gds Tank Div which, because they left toward Neustadt/Dosse, possibly went to the Elbe River for field training.
- 25X1A Comment. According to the truck numbers, the train appears to have carried a mixed component of the 1st Mecc Div.
