1. On 12 June 1951, Vienna Aspern (P 49/X 49) airfield was occupied by 67 Pe-2s and five biplanes. About five to eight additional Pe-2s were possibly stationed there. No other aircraft types were parked at the field. There was no flying between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. [Redacted]
