The former airfield at Markersdorf (O 49/W 78) was observed between 9:30 and 10 a.m. on 14 June 1951. All the buildings at the field were destroyed. The landing field was under cultivation. Some concrete strips and taxiways were partly damaged. The longest concrete strip was about 700 to 1,000 meters x 12 meters. It appeared that the field was not even used temporarily by Soviet aircraft. #

25X1A [REDACTED] Comment. This observation agrees with information received during the preceding years. It is believed that the field has been abandoned by the Soviets.
