Between 4 and 5 p.m. on 11 June 1951, Parndorf (P 48/X 77) airfield was occupied by 10 single-engine fighters and 2 single-engine biplanes. The fighters were mid-wing monoplanes with slim fuselages, in line engines and rounded wing tips. Five trucks were parked at the field. The brick buildings at the field were occupied by officers and the temporary buildings were occupied by EM. According to local residents, the airfield was put in operation on 10 June 1951. *

Comment. In preceding years, the airfield was occupied by Soviet units for training purposes during the summer months. Previously, only bomber units were stationed there whereas a fighter unit is now reported for the first time. It is not known at which airfield the fighters were stationed previously.
