On 17 May 1951, Strasshof (P 49/S 50) airfield was occupied by 76 Pe-2s and two biplanes. Twenty air force officers were seen at the officers' billets. Two Pe-2s with windows on the side of the fuselage were observed at the aircraft repair shop in Deutsch-Wagram. [REDACTED]
