1. Between 7 and 9 May 1951, a guard detail of 15 men wearing blue service color was seen in Kattner Settlement. Some motor vehicle sheds which had been dismantled were erected again. No motor vehicles were seen. *

2. About 250 to 300 troops were quartered in Jaeger Kaserne and the former provincial administrative building. *

3. On 7 May, six railroad cars loaded with empty fuel containers, shipment-record No 64/10348, were seen at Eisenstadt railroad station en route to Liesing (O 49/X 38). ***

* Comment. In April 1951, some of the quarters on the northwestern edge of Wiener Neustadt airfield in Eisenstadt were evacuated by Soviet Air Force soldiers who were transferred to Fischau. The vacant quarters were allegedly to be re-occupied by Soviet Army units. Observations at Trauersdorf airfield the personnel of which are billeted in Eisenstadt, give no indications of the present occupation of the field. Two fighter regiments were previously stationed there.

Comment. This is a normal supply shipment.
