In February 1951, a flight mechanic of the Maszovlet Firm observed that Debrecen (R 48/K 40) airfield was occupied by Soviet aircraft. About six to seven fighters of the Bell Aircobra type, some PO-2s and TU-2s were seen there. Several Soviets were starting a Bell Aircobra plane. *
