1. On 12 June 1951, the Schuetzen Kaserne on Trammer Chaussee, Eberswalde (N 53/V 08), quarters about 800 troops who wore red-bordered black epaulets with tank, artillery, supply and signal insignia. Most of the units from the installation were allegedly at the Jueterbog and Templin troop training grounds. JS-2 tank [REDACTED] and two rocket launchers were seen in the billeting area. A fuel depot of five bunkers with a total capacity of about 250,000 liters was located in the northeastern corner of the billeting area. Another fuel depot of undetermined capacity was located on the southern side of the installation. The two depots were filled up with fuel during the days preceding 12 June. [REDACTED]

2. The number of troops quartered in the Artillerie Kaserne on Freienwalder Strasse between 10 and 12 June could not be determined. Soldiers observed in the billeting area wore tank and artillery insignia. [REDACTED] the survey unit (sic) from the installation had moved to the Ahlbeck area between 5 and 7 June. Most of the troops from the installation were allegedly at the troop training grounds of Jueterbog and Templin. [REDACTED]

* Comment. No previous reports have mentioned rail shipments of troops from the Schuetzen Kaserne to Jueterbog or Templin. Reports [REDACTED] have always stated that this barracks installation, [REDACTED] in which headquarters units of the Fourth Gds Mecz Army are carried, was occupied to capacity. [REDACTED] The two fuel depots at the installation are reported for the first time. A fuel depot with a capacity of 250,000 liters may be a rear service installation, but such a capacity appears too large to be an organizational installation. The Artillerie Kaserne quartered components of the 6th Gds Mecz Div which have been at the Templin troop training grounds since the end of April 1951. [REDACTED]
