- On 31 May, an emplacement of two 37-mm AA guns, and two small wooden sheds were seen in a patch of woods near Stalags (former PW base camps) I through III, about 200 meters east of the fork formed by the roads running from-Luckenwalde to Frankenfoerde and Frankenfelde. - 25X1C(5) The AA gun emplacement is reported for the first time.
- The information agrees with previous reports on Stalags I through III. The was also observed by the inconnection with a game of soccer on 25 kay 1951. It perongs to 25X1C^(.7.) 25X1C the 91st Gds RL Regt in the RAD (Reich Labor Service) camp at 25X1C
