All officers of the Bereitschaft without assignment, especially Unterkommissare, were billeted in the installation in the Buergerau where they received special training.

Comment. The information on location, equipment and officers of VFD in Gotha agrees with provious information.

However, the organization of the seven Condenabteilungen mentioned in the present report deviates from that of other VPDs. It is believed that, although the VFD had only three Sonderabteilungen at first, it now has attained the standard organization.

Bicycle Abteilung and motorcycle Abteilung probably now constitute two Zuege of the recommaissance Sonderabteilunge. It is believed that one of the Condenabteilungen is a mortar unit.

Comment. The method of moving the VPD elements to a tent camp for training cycles has been previously observed with other VPDs, such as the VPDs in Weissenfels and Gera. This method is an adaption of the Soviet practice of conducting summer training at camps.

Comment. The arrival of about 50 recruits per day for the six VPDs in land Thuringia would constitute a total of 6,000 recruits, i.e. an increase by 1,000 police for each VPD, from January to April 1951. This figure therefore appears grossly exaggerated.
