1. Prior to late March 1951, the Volkspolizei Dienststelle (VPD) II in Erfurt was located in the Henne Kaserne. It numbered about 1,600 police, with new personnel being recruited continually, and was organized into 4 Kommandos and an undetermined number of Sonderabteilungen of various branches of service.
2. The VPD was equipped with infantry weapons of all types, an undetermined number of guns of various calibers, 1 T-34 tank, 1 armored reconnaissance car and 1 SP gun.
3. The officers of the unit included VP Inspekteur Smollerz, (fnu), commanding officer; VP Kommandeur Ernst, (fnu), assignment undetermined; VP Kommissar Schoenemann, (fnu), personnel officer, who came from Muehlhausen; VP Oberrat Billerich, (fnu), commanding officer of 3d Kommando; VP Kommissar Langer, (fnu), training officer of 3d Kommando; VP Kommissar Klotz, (fnu), commanding officer of 3d Sonderabteilung; and VP Oberkommissar Becker, (fnu), training officer of 3d Sonderabteilung. *
