1. On 3 June 1951, four jet fighters with the blue numbers 01, 26, 36, and 75 and passenger car were parked on the western end of the runway at Wittstock airfield. Four stand-by fighters with the blue numbers 09, 11, 21, and 96 were parked on the eastern end of the runway.

2. On 7 June, 14 jet fighters of the MiG-15 type and two biplanes were counted at the field. Between 1 and 15 June, there was no flying. Two biplanes made individual flights on 16 June.
