1. Prior to 12 April, the Soviet central distributing agency Petushkov in Werder (N 3/2 53) on the Havel River had [REDACTED] 25X1C
 25X1C [REDACTED] It consisted of five sections designated by Roman numerals: Section I was for shirts, underwear and furs; Section Ia for civilian clothes and uniforms; Section II for all sorts of food; Section IIIa for footwear and household articles; and Section III for stationary, toys, tools, watches, cameras and accessories, and fancy wares.
2. The agency had purchasing agents for footwear, furs and stationary in Leipzig; for shirts, underwear, socks and bicycles in Chemnitz; for rayon, silk, woollen fabrics, bedlinen and carpets in Zwickau; for knitted and woven goods and household articles in Weimar; for tools, cameras with accessories, watches, kitchen gear, curtains and cloth fabrics in Dresden; and for trunks and suitcases in Neukirch.
3. Units which were supplied by the agency in Werder included Unit Rebus in Jueterbog-Altes Lager which, in turn, supplied the air force units in Oranienburg and Werneuchen; Unit Gurtovoy at Zerbst airfield; Unit Makoyev at Finsterwalde airfield; Air Force Unit Gorshkov in Altenburg; Unit Timoshenkov at Heringsdorf-Ahlbeck airfield. Air Force Unit Mishenkov in Cottbus; Unit Luntyanov at the airfield and troop training grounds of Wittstock; Air Force Unit Zulayev in Wittenberg; Air Force Unit Belayev in Grossenhain; Air Force Unit Gitun in Brandenburg which, in turn, supplied the affiliated tank repair shop in Kirchmoeser; Air Force Unit Sviedlov in Doeberitz-Olympisches Dorf; and Unit Besrockov. The cover names of the aforementioned units were the names of officers holding ranks from lieutenant up to and including major. The agency in Werder also supplied Store No 5 in the sanatorium at Koenigswusterhausen; Store No 6 in the sanatorium at Bad Saarow; and Store No 10 in Rangsdorf.



The motor pool of the central distributing agency in Werder consisted of 5 three-ton ZIS-5 trucks, 1 seven-ton MAN truck, 1 seven-ton Krupp-Diesel truck, 2 three-ton Opel-Blitz trucks, 2 three-ton trailers, 2 five-ton trailers, and 4 sedans of different types. All the vehicles had numbers with the prefix letter E, and were sent to Glauchau for general repairs. *
