- 25X1 1. The Polish training ship [redacted] was formerly the "Horst Wessel" [redacted] Ship and crew had an unfavorable appearance.
- 25X1 2. The "Brantas", a motor ship of the Stinnes Lines, was stopped along with another ship in the restricted zone before Reval in late May. Both ships were released after several days' detention.
- 25X1 3. [redacted] Russian warships are seldom seen in the western portion of the Gulf of Finland.
