1. On 24 May 1951, Parndorf (P 43/X 77) was not occupied and no motor vehicles were seen. *
2. About 20 air force soldiers were mowing the landing field on 25 May. According to local residents, Soviets had said that the work had to be completed by 8 June since the field was to be re-occupied on 10 June. **

* [REDACTED] Comment. On 16 and 17 April 1951, the airfield was occupied by a bomber regiment equipped with Pe-2s. The regiment probably came from Deutsch Wagram where one of the regiments previously stationed there had left on 17 May.

** [REDACTED] Comment. These statements are believed to be credible. It is probable that the field is to be reoccupied in June since a bomber regiment was also stationed at the field during the summer of 1950.
