On 23 May 1951, Wiener Neustadt (O 48/X 35) airfield was occupied by about 58 fighters with in-line engines, 43 of which were counted, 3 jet fighters, about 9 Pe-2s, 6 of which were counted, 4 twin-engine transports, and 4 biplanes. Twelve fighters were parked on the western edge of the field, not far from Feuerwerksanstalt (pyrotechnic plant). \* Two fighters with radial engines made 15-minute flights. The pilots were changed after each landing. Truck

2. Three Pe-2s were parked at Theresienfeld. One Pe-2 was under repair. Four van-like trucks and three other trucks, [Redacted] were seen there. Air force troops were quartered in the former Nachrichten Kaserne. [Redacted] were seen.

\* Comment. The information that the field is occupied by conventional aircraft agrees with previous observations. The number of jet planes is considerably lower than observed on 27 April. Since no reports have been received in the meantime it is not known whether most of the jet fighters have been transferred or were flying on 23 May. The total occupation of the airfield by air units is not known but one fighter regiment equipped with conventional fighters is stationed there, whereas the following units are presumed to be located at the field: One fighter regiment equipped with conventional fighters which possibly came from Trauersdorf; one fighter regiment equipped with jet aircraft; and one air transport squadron equipped with LI-2s and Pe-2s.
