

- Chinese Communist regular troops in Kwangtung, which total about 110,000, are disposed as follows:
 - The 38 and 40 Armies are stationed as follows: in the suburbs of Canton, along the Canton-Huahsien (113-18, 23-29) and Canton-Tsengch'eng (113-49, 23-16) highways, and in the Honan (113-16, 23-05) area.
 - Parts of the 42, 144, and 47 Armies are garrisoning the islands of the Pearl River estuary.
 - Parts of the 12, 141, 147, and 19 Armies are on the coast near Huiyang (114-26, 23-05), Haifeng (115-20, 22-58), and Infeng (115-38, 22-58).
 - The 43 Army is in the coastal area near Chaoan (116-37, 23-42) and d٥
 - Part of the 48 Army is along the Canton-Hankow railway.
- On 8 and 9 July TSENG Sheng met with Chinese Communist officers and Soviet advisers in Huiyang. TSENG will command the defense forces in the Bias Bay area. These forces are to be under a new Huiyang-Haifeng defense headquarters.
