SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO. 25X1A



1. Inquiry made among Communist Party leaders in Costa Rica concerning any change of Soviet policy toward Latin America has yielded one indication which might tend to predict a change in commercial matters. The Partisans of Peace Committee in Costa Rica has received a note from their headquarters that on 1 October 1951 a conference is to be held in Moscow on economic problems exclusively.
2. Costa Rican Communist Party leaders have been requested to make preparations for the travel of a delegate to the Moscow conference. Although, according to source, the Political Commission of the Party has not come to any official decision, in unofficial conversations it has been indicated that Manuel Mora Valverde, president of the Communist Party, will undoubtedly be selected to represent Costa Rica at the projected conference.
