The following are excerpts from an undated letter received from an unidentifiable town in Hungary on 19 May 1951:

"Nothing worth mentioning has occurred since the Soviets left Koermend (I 48/C 76) and Szombathely (P 48/C 76). Small raids are sometimes made by Hungarian AVH personnel at night. The border guard units are being reinforced, and Soviet soldiers have been attached to them. The Partisans of Freedom receive intensive training. Letters and parcels from abroad are subject to strict censorship and control. AVH signal troops left Koermend for the lowlands. Sirens have been tested at several places. " *
