Hungarian Military Postal Numbers.

1. Hungarian military postal numbers identified from 21 to 30 May 1951 included 1344 in connection with a military unit in Nagybjom (Y 4/A 66) which announced the desertion of a soldier of the 1930 class; 1935 in connection with a military unit in Keczel (Y 6/N 51) which announced the desertion of a soldier of the 1930 class who had fled from Camp Keczel; and 7130 in connection with Camp Nagykoeroes (Q 48/O 06) which announced the desertion of two soldiers of the 1930 and 1931 classes who had fled on 16 May 1951. *

Military Hospital No 2 in Pecs.

2. On 30 May 1951, military hospital No 2 was identified in Pecs. The desertion of a soldier of the 1930 class was reported.

[REDACTED] Camp Keczel is probably a troop camp of wooden barracks buildings or tents where Hungarian troops are quartered during the summer training period. Keczel is situated several kilometers south of Kiskoeroes, from where postal No 1935 was reported in connection with an artillery unit in May 1951.
