- On 30 July, the North Korean and Chinese Communist Combined Headquarters was in Songchon (126-13, 39-15) (BU 6048). The Chinese Communist 4 Field Army Headquarters was at Suan (126-22, 38-42) (BT 7186). The Chinese Communist 3 Field Army Headquarters was at Hoeyang (127-37, 38-42) (CT 8084). Headquarters of the Chinese Communist 2 Field Army was in the Kumgang-san (128-07, 38-37) (DT 2374) area. The Chinese Communist I Mechanized Corps was in the Hwachang (126-30, 39-15) (BU 8447) area.
- In late July, there were no organized non-oriental combat units in North Korea (C-6). Non-orientals in North Korea include a Hungarian Medical Corps. 2. Rumanian labor delegates and the "International War Effort Mission." The last furnishes information for Communist propaganda. The members are mostly newspapermen led by TASS and China Central News Agency Representatives.
