- On 25 June the Ministry of Education announced the plans for enrolling students in the various military cadre schools throughout the country after victory was completed. During July the schools had already started enrolling new students under this plan.
- Standards for admission of new students for this coming year have been greatly lowered. High school<sup>1</sup> and senior primary school pupils may be admitted. Courses which may be undertaken are labeled air force, navy, armored force, artillery, engineering, medical warfare, anti-aircraft defense, meteorology, tele-communications, surveying, communications, and sanitation. The quota of students for North and Central China exceeds 250,000.
