SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

- Under the terms of a barter deal concluded between USEA and Petalinport Trust of Strich on or about 14 June 1951, 1911 is supplying 216 tons of Auraluminum in return for approximately 135 tens of aluminum of 99.5% purity.
- 2. Metalimport Trust has already procured 50 tons of pure aluminum from Alfred Post, owner of the Edrich firm of Gebruder Ingels, paying approximately 240,000 for the metal. This aluminum was located in Vienna and has been shipped to Genoa (transit), whence it will be shipped back again to Schenker & Co., Vienna, who will hand it over to Juschwneschtrans.
- 3. Both parties to the deal have put up performance bonds with Soviet Military Bank, No. 2111* in Vienna.
- 4. A further barter deal between the same parties, under the terms of which USIA is supplying 50,000 tens of mazut fuel oil against structural steel and stool plate, has also been signed. Metalimport Trust is reselling the mazut to the firm of Tajabuje* of Venice.
- 5. Metalignort Trust has already delivered 60 tons of I-beam girders to USIA and was about to deliver a further 320 tons early in July. These girders are being obtained from France and are shipped to Vienna by way of Antwerp. The Vaduz firm of Comac Industries is acting as an intermediary. 25X1A

Comment: According to a report from another agency, #2111 in the Soviet Military Benk was used in a transaction between USIA and Heselfruber.

Comment: No firm of this name was found in the current Venice 25X1A phone directory. Possibly this is a misspelling of Tacliabuc, Ciuseppe, dealer in fuels, 13 Porto Marriera, Venice. Such a misspelling might occur #6% if a Gorman-speaking person at supped to write the name phonotically.
