The reparations production plan at Warnemunde was more than fulfilled on a reparations value basis, but not on a target basis. The ships Lenkoran and Karclia, part of the 1950 plan, are still in the shipyard.

Object Lenkoran - Postmonement of deadline because of the Gefahrenklasse II, delays on deliveries from sub-contractors (Nest), new requests from the construction surveyors. As of 4 April 1951 - 94 % completed.

Object Karelia - Delayed clarification of specifications (by the Soviet Control Commission), extensive changes in the bilge system, additional building in of 110 tons of ballast. As of 4 April 1951 - 95.0 % completed.
