SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

- Before the war, the Siemens-Planiawerke A.G. had two main plants, one in Ratibor and one in Berlin-Lichtenberg. The Ratibor plant is now in Poland and the Lichtenberg plant was used as a basis for reconstruction of the firm in East-Germany.* The Lichtenberg factory is divided into two parts, the carbon rod (Kohlenstifte) plant and the electrode plant (Electrodenfabrik).
- 2. The firm is an SAG and belongs to SAG Kabel. Under some kind of lease agreement it is usually considered a VEB (Volkseigener Betrieb). ***
- 3. The chief personalities of the Siemens-Planiawerke Lichtenberg are as follows:

- 4. Production has lately increased but quality is poor. There are no longer many reparations deliveries but considerable interest has been shown by satellite countries.
- 5. Graphite rods are sent to Bitterfeld for graphitizing (Graphitierung), 25X1A

Comment: Siemens in West-Germany has reopened the Siemens-25X14Anlawerke AG branch in Meitingen near Augsburg.

Comment: The Lichtenberg factory has been previously reported as one of the 23 SAG plants which were returned as "People's property" in June 1950.
