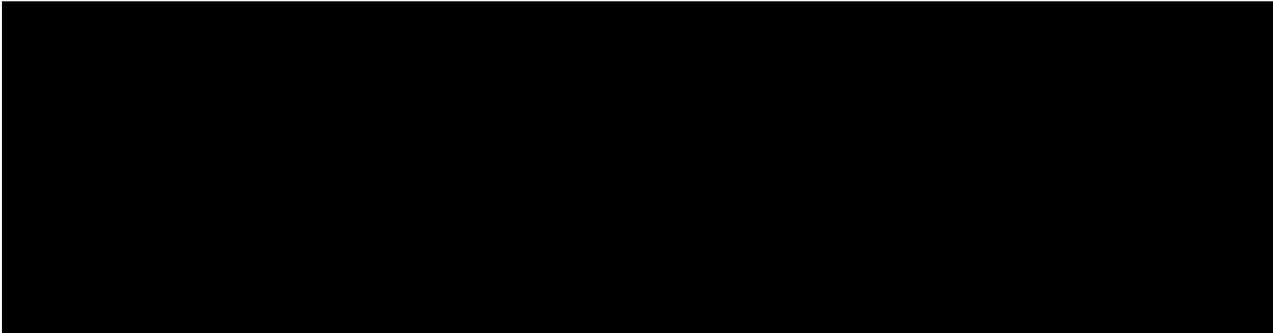

1. It is alleged that the Soviet Union has arrived at a secret agreement with the Hungarian government under which Soviet troops will remain on Hungarian soil indefinitely.
2. The reported agreement evades the provision of the peace treaty with Hungary which allows Soviet troops to remain in the country only until the completion of a treaty with Austria, and only for the purpose of guarding supply lines and communications to the Russian occupation forces in Austria. According to this report, the Soviet-Hungarian treaty for non-aggression and mutual assistance contains a secret clause authorizing the Russians to transfer their headquarters from Austria to Hungary after signature of an Austrian peace treaty, and to keep it there for an unspecified period.
