SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. The North Korean Labor Party is losing control of the Democratic Youth Alliance, Democratic Womens Alliance, Farmers Alliance, and the labor supporters Association (Cho-Kuk Bo-Ul Hu-Won Hwei) (祖國保衛隊協會) to reassert its power and generally to assist the war effort by dominating labor, political, and religious organizations; to procure military supplies, to repair roads, to expedite agricultural production, to assist the families of North Korean Army personnel, and to spread propaganda.
2. The current propaganda of this association stresses that the United Nations are requesting peace for the purpose of strengthening their forces and rearming; this objective will be countered by the reinforcement of the Chinese Communist Army and the receipt of much additional support from the USSR, thus assuring an ultimate Communist victory.
