1. On 6 July 1951, the Hindenburg Kaserne on Theodorstrasse, Schwerin (H 54/T 46), quartered about 500 to 600 soldiers who wore red-bordered black epaulets with artillery insignia. [redacted] the troops constituted the entire complement of the artillery unit there. Infantry training at squad level, was observed, but there was no gun drill. 50X1-HUM

2. Genexes with signal insignia were at the two gates of the installation on 28 June and 5 July. Troops, apparently recruits, received basic training in the billeting area. Motor vehicles [redacted] were seen in the billeting area. No guns were identified. Motor vehicles seen in the billeting area [redacted] 50X1-HUM

Prior to 6 July, half of the buildings of the Krueger Kaserne on Ludwigsluststrasse were occupied by an estimated 500 troops who wore red-bordered black epaulets, including some with artillery insignia. Routine training activity was observed. 50X1-HUM

4. On 4 July, the Moltke Kaserne on Ludwigsluststrasse quartered about 200 men who wore red-bordered black epaulets, some with tank insignia. No training activity was noticed. Motor vehicles seen in the billeting area [redacted] 50X1-HUM

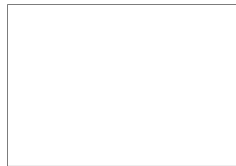
5. On 6 July, the Adolf Hitler Kaserne on Ludwigsluststrasse was occupied only partly. Gate guards wore black-bordered crimson epaulets. [redacted]

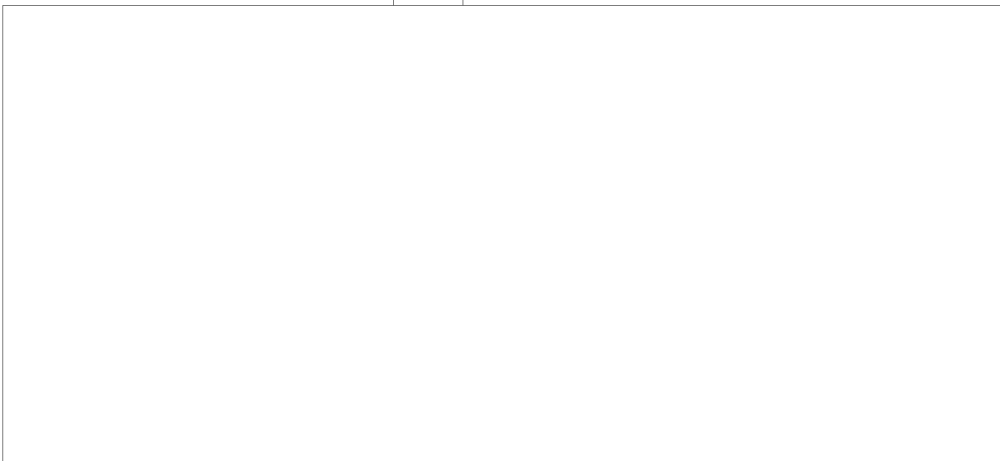
