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- The Store Foundry in Celje is principally engaged in the production of heavy rollers necessary to all branches of Yugoslav industry. Only small rollers up to 600 kilograms in weight could be produced by the foundry until recently but, with the installation of a new type of furnace, (said to be the first of its kind in Yugoslavia), the foundry now can produce rollers weighing up to twenty tons. Factory equipment includes three cupola furnaces and one "fire" furnace.
- Ninety workers' brigades are employed at the Store foundry, rolling mill, Siemens-Martin furnaces, and mechanics' workshop.
- Management personnel of the Store Foundry in Celje includes:
