On 1 July 1951, 69 single-engine low-wing monoplanes with in-line engines were parked in two rows on the northern edge of Reinsdorf airfield, where flying was repeatedly observed recently. About five biplanes were also parked at the field. There was no flying on 1 July. Motor vehicles
