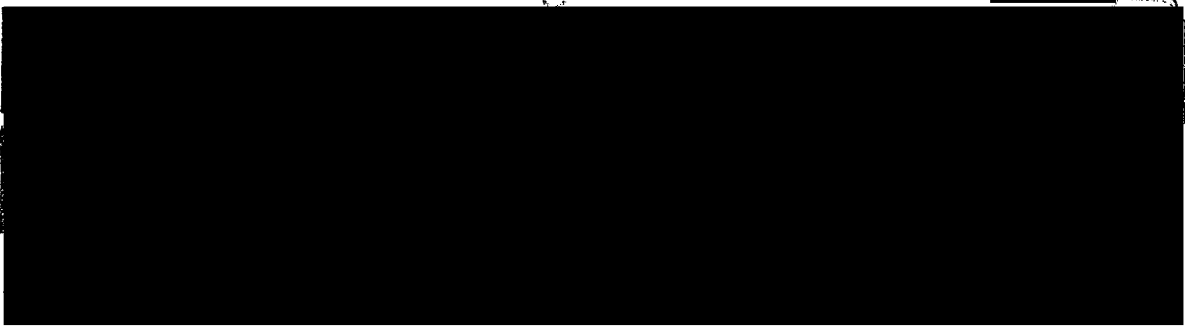

The departure of Danilo Jimenez Veiga, secretary of the Costa Rican Pro-Peace Committee, and his wife, Virginia, for France and Switzerland on 27 July 1951 was described by source as having no Party significance. Jimenez and his bride were merely taking a honeymoon trip, according to source, who added that the last word from the Political Commission concerning Jimenez was that his position in the Party was under critical scrutiny. The general attitude of Jimenez toward Party affairs in Costa Rica has been one of neglect and lack of interest, and as a result the Political Commission is trying to replace him with Rafael Angel Lluvere as secretary of the Pro-Peace Committee.

It is felt, however, that the possibility should be considered that Jimenez might be dropping local Party duties, and that this trip might be to initiate his activity in the international Communist organization. In the past, Jimenez was an active, so-called "militant" member of the Costa Rican Communist Party; he is reportedly still an active member of the United States Communist Party and is known to have been in touch with international figures connected with the recent Youth Festival in Berlin.
