1. [REDACTED] the Soviet Air Force in early June 1951 evacuated a group of 25 to 30 twin-engine bombers from the Parndorf airfield. These aircraft were replaced on or about 1 July 1951 by 24 fighter aircraft, possibly jet fighters.
2. In Rohrau (Bezirksgericht: Druck a/d Leitha) an underground gasoline depot built by the Germans is being used by the Soviets to store aviation gasoline for aircraft at the Parndorf field.
3. Sometime prior to 23 July 1951 five fighter planes arrived at the Parndorf field. Present air strength at Parndorf consists of 15 single-engine mono-planes and two single-engine biplanes as well as accompanying gasoline tank trucks. Tents which have been set up at a distance of approximately two kilometers from the airfield may indicate the arrival of troop reinforcements.
