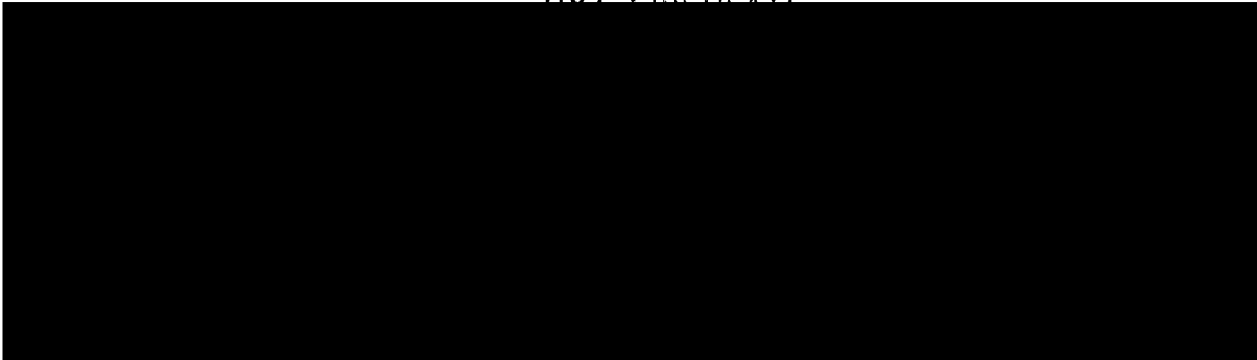

- 1. The 5 Infantry Regiment moved from Ruse around 25 April. [REDACTED] 25X1X
[REDACTED] There were about 500 to 600 men, all of them infantrymen. All carried rifles, engineering equipment (sic), and a knapsack. About 15 horse carriages and mobile kitchens accompanied them. [REDACTED] they were transferred either to their headquarters or to the Turkish border areas.
- 2. The recall to active duty of reserves between the ages of 30 and 35 was begun in Ruse in early May 1951. Some of these reactivated troops remain in Ruse, while others are transferred to places unknown [REDACTED] 25X1X
- 3. Since about 27 May, young Turks who had already served in the army have not been issued exit visas to emigrate to Turkey. This has caused great regret among the Turkish minority in Bulgaria.
