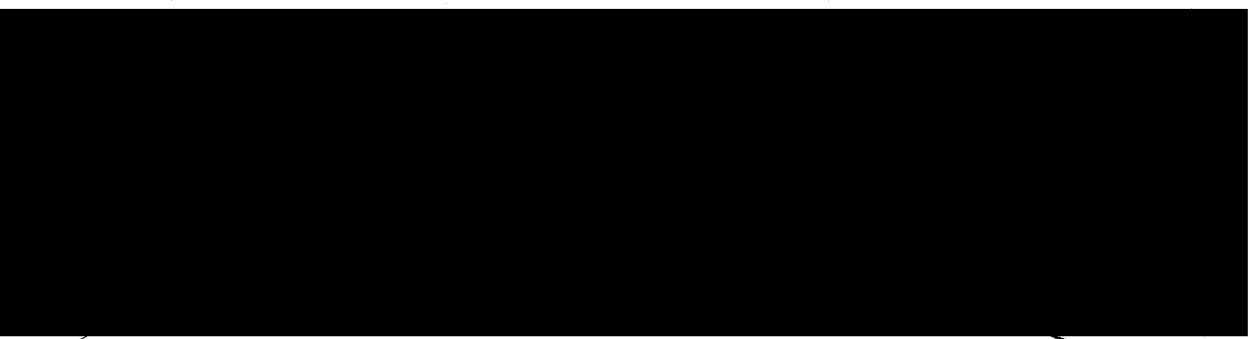

## 4. The following are active Chinese Communists in Bandjermasin:

SIN Liong Ho           Runs a bookshop; imports propaganda material for sale and distribution.

SO Jo Kie               Owner of Toko Surabaya; collects money from Chinese community for the support of pro-Communist Chinese organizations.

BOK Thay Tong         Manager of the Toko Min Seng; active in the Bandjermasin Chinese Communist movement.

PEK Thioe Tong        Owner of the Tiong Foa Rumah Obat (drugstore); an active member of Chinese Communist organizations in Bandjermasin.

## 5. The following Chinese companies are reported to be connected with the local Chinese Communist movement in Bandjermasin:

## 6. The following are large rubber growers and processors in the Bandjermasin area:

Ek Liong Hin Company   Offices on Djalan Rantawan Kuliling, Hilir, Bandjermasin; its estate lands produce 1,500 tons of rubber a year; most of it flatbark rubber.

Teng Thio Company     Offices on Djalan Rantawan, Bandjermasin; uses trademark "Bintang"; produces 600 tons rubber annually; Blanket A, B, & C and flatbark rubber.

Hok Tong Company      Djalan Teluk Dalam, Bandjermasin; grows and processes 6,000 tons of rubber a year; Blanket A, B, C, & D and flatbark rubber.

GOEY Keng Thong       Of Mandangan; grows 1,000 tons a year of Blanket C and flatbark rubber

SOE Kai Gwan          His plantations grow about 1,000 tons of rubber a year; mostly flatbark rubber.

## 7. Besides growing rubber on their estates and processing it in their own plants, the above have connections for exporting their products.

## 8. The following firms in Bandjermasin are engaged in the export of rubber which has been bought from estates and small holders and are the principal exporters of rubber in this area:

This firm has business connections in Djakarta, Semarang, and Singapore; owns motorship HIMALAYA.

9. The Sam Hap Company and the Kwee Chin To Company are known to have Communist connections and are suspected of exporting rubber to Communist China. The directors of the Sam Hap Company are brothers of LIEM Koen Hian, a prominent Communist in Djakarta. These brothers are believed to carry on business transactions between Bandjermasin and Djakarta.
