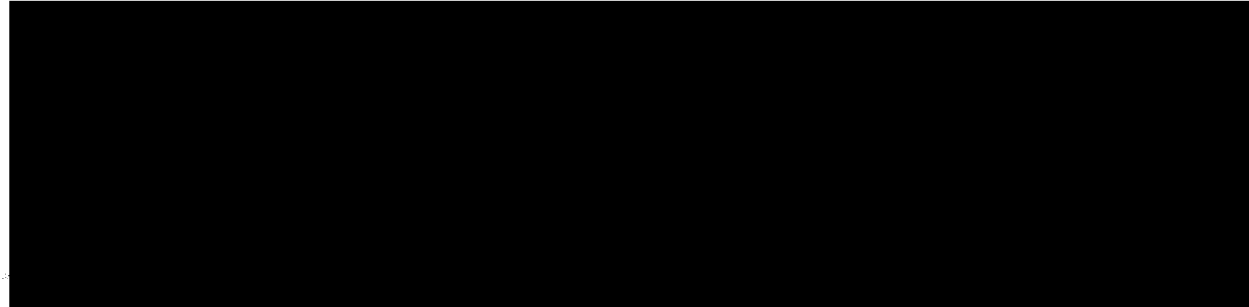

- 25X1X 1. Radio Bergen.
- a. An 800 watt radio transmitter operating in the 13 to 100 meter band was built in Lohme in 1950 and to this was added a 5 KW Radio-telephone and a 10 KW telegraph transmitter.
 - b. Also operating in Lohme are the following:
 - 1 - Naval DF
 - 5 - Monitor receivers
 - 2 - All-wave receivers
 - c. The operations building as well as the antennae and other necessary installations in Lohme with a substitute location have been finished.
 - d. A 2.5 to 10 KW Radio-telephone-telegraph broadcasting in the 500 to 1,000 meter band, and a 5 to 10 KW border-wave transmitter operating in the 80 to 200 meter band are now finished and will probably start operating in July 1951.
2. Between Lohme and Sassnitz, there are two small radio stations of the Seepolizei. Their type is not known.
3. There are seven or eight receivers and two direction finders now in operation in Glowe. A building for these receivers is now under construction.
4. The modulation cable between Glowe and Lohme has been put into operation.
5. A special circuit has been installed between the KDO in Bergen and the Sea Police School at Sassnitz.
6. From Moewenort to Arkona to Breege to Glowe a special circuit has been set up and is in operation. At each of these points, there is a radio station of the Seepolizei.
7. A telephone line for Post Office and Police use has been set up between Stralsund, Rostock, and Wismar.
8. A telephone line has been installed for the use of the Seepolizei between Bergen and Stralsund.
