The following is a key to the attached sketch of Brand Airfield:

- A - Brand Railroad Station
- B - Workers' Canteen
- C - German Workers' Barracks
- D - Cleared land with barracks under construction.
- E - 15 to 20 wooden barracks now occupied by about 700 ground-crew personnel. These soldiers have shoulder-boards with black edging. Vehicles with the following numbers have been observed:
 E 5-65-65, E 5-65-67, E 5-65-69. The drivers of these trucks and the fifteen to twenty soldiers in each of them have shoulder-boards of the air training command.
- F - Turnpike on the road to Schoonwalde with double guard of P.
- G - Turnpike on the main road to Krausnick guarded by one Russian civilian with a pistol. This guard wears an arm-band of the Kommandatura.
- H - Guardhouse with telephone.
- J - Krausnick Mill.
- K - Krausnick
- L - Main railroad line to Lubben and Cottbus.
- M - Main railroad line to Koeningwusterhausen and Berlin.
- N - Road to Driesen
- O - Road to Stackow
- P - Runway under construction with its beginning near point C. After present work is completed, it will be about 80 meters wide and will run about 300 meters long parallel to the main road from Brand to Krausnick.
- Q - Main road to the Reichsautobahn to Golszen.
