In May and June 1950, a fuel depot, located west of Felcsut (Q 48/Z 13), east of point 150 indicated on the map, scale 1:250,000, in the road fork formed by the Csakvar (Q 48/Z 02)-Bicske (Q 48/Z 13) and the Felcsut-Uj Barok (Q 48/Z 13) roads, was frequently observed by source. It had a frontage of about 200 meters along the Csakvar Bicske road and was enclosed by a high wire fence and equipped with two wooden watchtowers located near the road and some other watchtowers situated in the interior of the installation. The depot included several concrete manholes, arranged at distances of 20 to 25 meters. It was equipped with a railroad spur, entering the area from the north, on which tank cars were occasionally observed. The purpose of the depot could not be determined.
